The law of intellectual property deals with the ownership of intangibles - the innovative idea behind new technology, products, processes, designs or plant varieties, a brand, trade secret, or the goodwill associated with a business, product or service.

Intellectual Property Law in New Zealand is an authoritative and highly accessible legal commentary on one of the most dynamic areas of law in New Zealand.

The intangible nature of intellectual property, and the ease with which software and other information stored in digital media can be copied and disseminated, makes it especially vulnerable to infringement. Consequently, clearly defining the ownership and scope of the rights to intellectual property, and effective enforcement of these, is of increasing importance.

First published in August 2003 and now updated regularly, *Intellectual Property Law in New Zealand* is itself reflective of the changing world of idea and information transfer: the publication has never been published in paper. Use of digital technology allows easy linkages between commentary and legislation, and fast location and research of the many topics and concepts it contains.

Each of the subjects is covered in detail, with an overview, followed by detailed examination of the relevant legislation and case law. Links to many of the cases cited and the relevant legislation allow fast navigation, and the online version contains links to other websites and sources of supplementary information.

Searching

- Search across multiple Brookers Online databases simultaneously using the powerful MegaSearch feature;
- Search from any page. Use the "quick search" feature on any page to perform a simple free-text or document title search across a database;
- The intuitive Legislation Title Search Assistant makes it easy to find an Act or Regulation without knowing its exact title.

Navigation

- Research Trail feature allows you to back-track to a document accessed earlier in your session – so you never get lost;
- Related Content Menus. Brookers Online databases are fully integrated, meaning you will be able to link to any case law or precedents which relate to the legislation you have accessed, or vice versa;
- Preview Pane. Sometimes Related Content menus contain large numbers of links (such as case law related to frequently cited Acts). Here you can use the Preview Pane to "take a peek" at the linked documents without losing your place;
- Commentary Anywhere. Because Brookers Online is fully integrated, you can view legislative commentary from any product which contains the same legislation. For example, you can view commentary on the High Court Rules from *McGechan on Procedure* while you are using the Brookers *Company Law* database (subscription to both products required).

Printing

- "Print this Document" means you can print the page you're looking at easily and quickly;
- "My Selections" lets you select multiple documents to print as you go and compile them at the end of your session to a single print-out, or export them to PDF;
- "Export to PDF" is particularly useful for creating PDFs of whole Acts or Regulations.

Other Features

- Bookmarking. Add a document or frequently-used search to your "Favourites" menu and find things faster next time;
- Email. Use the Email Link features to send a link to a document to a colleague;
- Hide/Show. Brookers Online displays commentary and annotations section-by-section by default. You can hide this to read legislation on your screen faster, or to exclude the commentary and annotations from your print version.
